Makes decision on size and shape very difficult

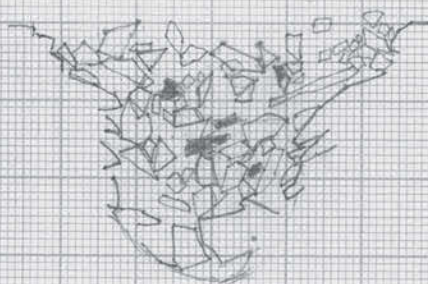
