DATE EXPOSED 1/8/80 DATE COMPLETED 9/8/80

DESCRIPTION Post-hole. Showing an area of small burnt stones within larger area of more scattered burning & disrupted. bed. limastone on the edge of a substantial fissure in surface of layer 2. Unsubstantial. Under because of fissure but extent of p.h. quite clear due to distinctive fill of small burnt stones (pink & blue) & loose earth, some packing stones indicating post-pipe. Extreme E. edge of p.h. topped by E. edge of cutting.

MAX. WIDTH AND DIRECTION c. 30cm N-S

MAX. LENGTH AND DIRECTION c. 40cm to edge of cutting E-W

MAX. DEPTH/HEIGHT THICKNESS c. 41cm

OVERLIES Shattered surface of bedrock

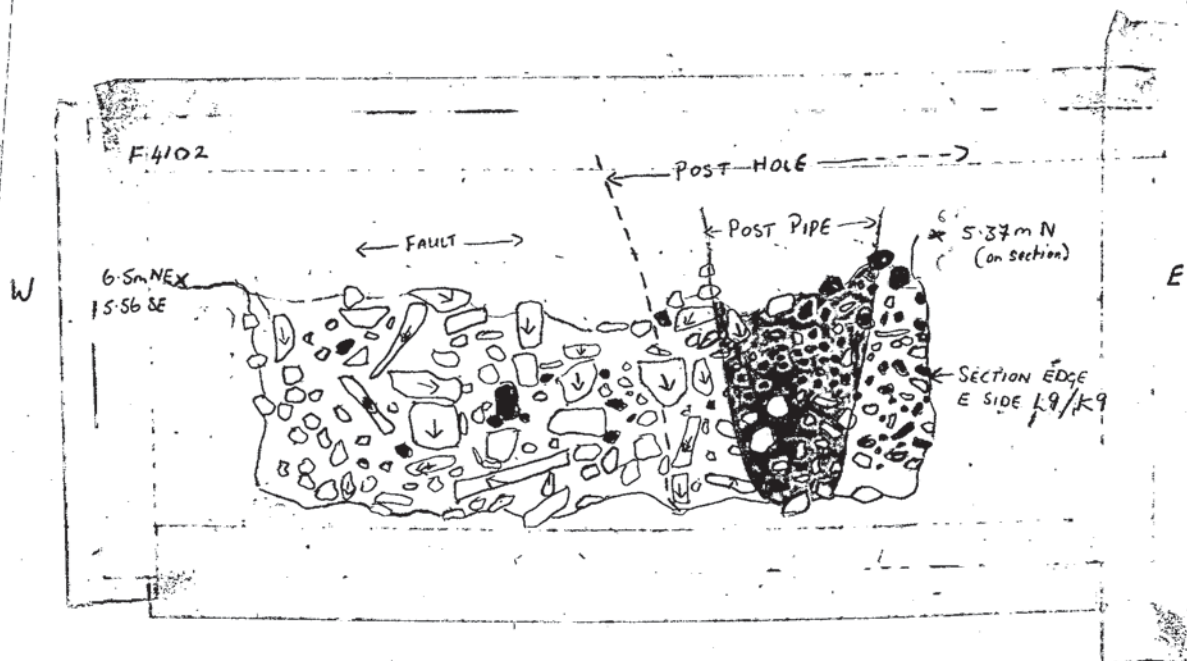
