DESCRIPTION Posthole. Showing as small patch of burnt-limestone or vertical packing stones in surface of layer ②. Excavated hole failed to have any firm edges due to the surrounding disturbed bedrock but limits of the feature could be identified by its fill of loose earth, small burnt stones & many finds, giving quite an impression of a narrow p.h.

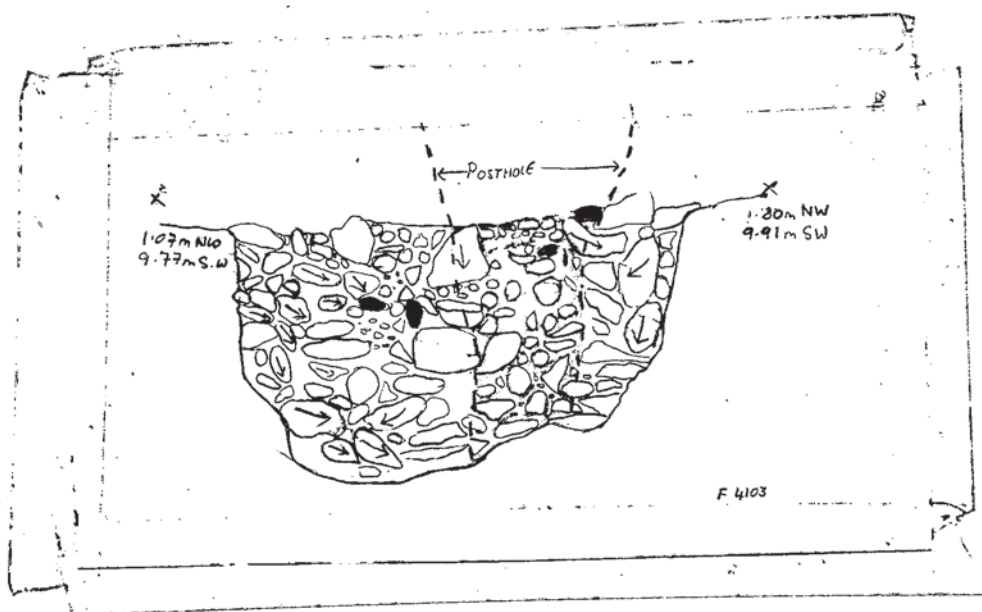
