DATE COMPLETED 19/8/80

DESCRIPTION Depression in natural gull filled with brownish red bent limestone gull with a few shreds many vertical & some bent; some leaching at bottom. Excavated from level of L9 plan (3) where it showed as an area of brownish-red chippie.

MAX. WIDTH AND DIRECTION 1.40m E-W (east edge of feature to west edge of cutting L9)

MAX. LENGTH AND DIRECTION c. 1.50m N-S

MAX. DEPTH/HEIGHT THICKNESS 8cm

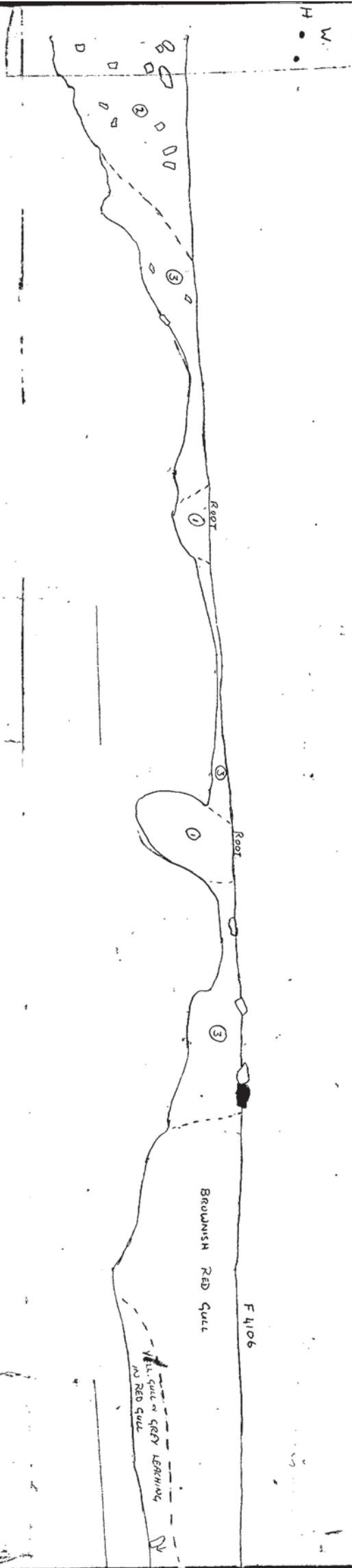
ASSOCIATED FINDS flint, bone & burnt bone
