CUTTING L9 (05.15)

DATE EXPOSED 10/8/80 DATE COMPLETED 19/8/80

DESCRIPTION Deep hollow in natural gull filled with very red burnt limestone gull; a few small stones lying flat against upper sides & bottom, finds also high up on sloping sides; some leaching at bottom. Excavated from level of L9 a plan (3) where it showed as area of red chipples.

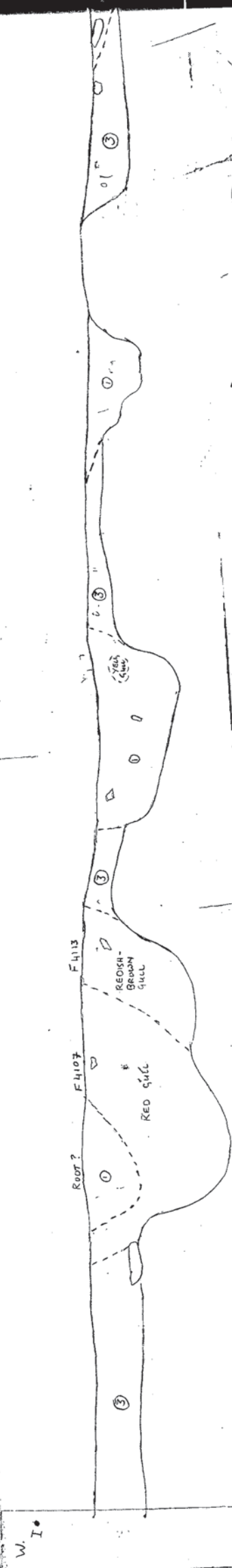
ASSOCIATED FINDS flint, pot, burnt bone & charcoal.

COMMENT Seems to be the ultimate in the general area of F 4106 i.e. deeper & filled with much redder chipples, neither feature cut each other but rather F 4106 surrounds F 4107 on the north west sides.

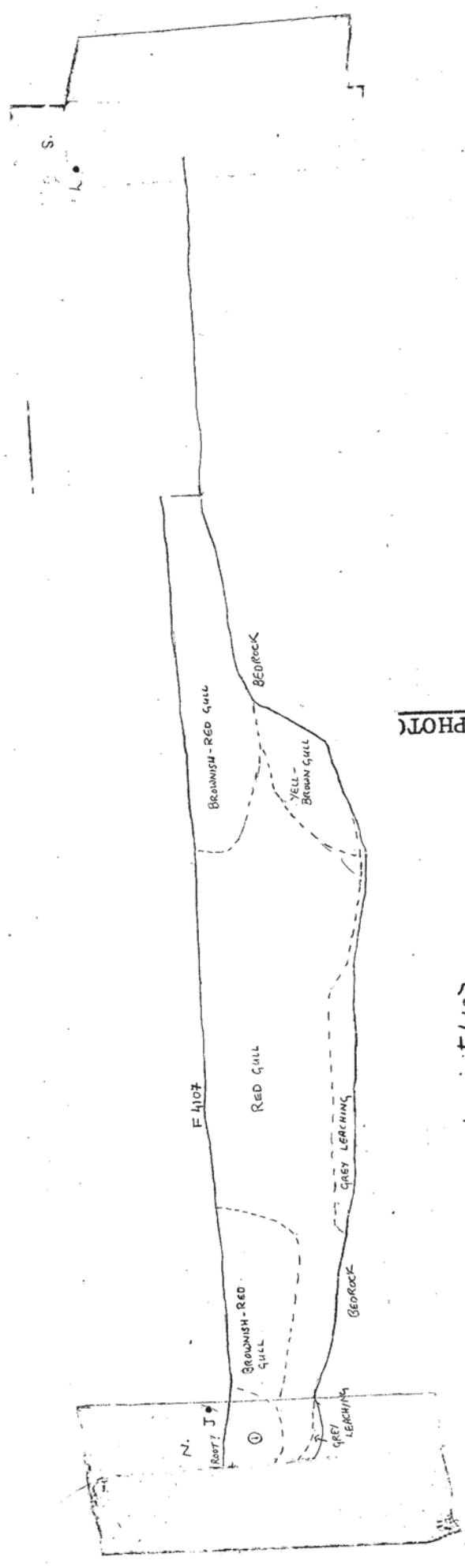
