## DESCRIPTION POSTHOLE

Showing as area of fine brown soil with patches of stones, many angled in it (one in surface of layer ③) (orange gull) (see Plan 4). Did not round sides & rounded bottom cut into solid bedrock. The upper fill as described above but also many packing stones some quite large & some many v. small - especially around the sides. At a depth of c. 30 cm the fill changed to a dark grey-brown soil with less stones & little burning & few finds (F 4115) beneath this was a stone shallow layer of sandy leached gull.

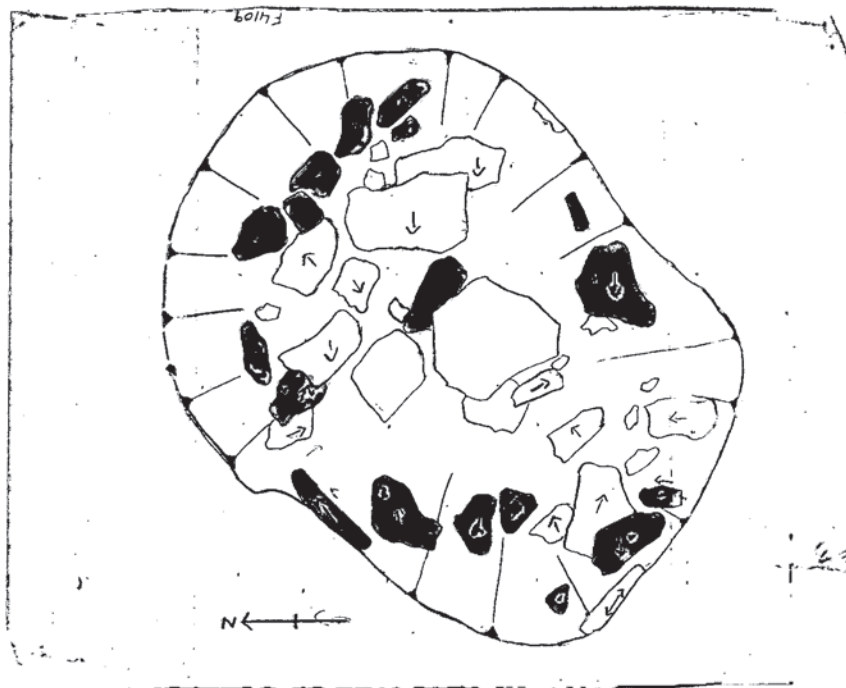
