DESCRIPTION Possible POSTHOLE. Found while excavating eastern half of F 4107, as only one side & half of bottom remaining cut into bedrock gull. Other side apparently destroyed by cutting of F 4107. Fill of darker reddish-brown earth easily distinguishable from the fill of F 4107.
