COMMENT The large ph F 2674, (which may even be a breble), is matched across the ditch by F2668 and F2687. The latter did not appear as early as the former. Although there are 10 post-holes (or doubles), it is thought that they form two separate groups: A: 6 poster at N.E. and a 4 poster on the S.W.

~~DIAGNOSIS~~ NO area suggesting a hearth was found, though F2672, with burned stones and bone at a high level on the ditch, could conceivably be associated with the six poster much pot - no contact with ditch fill.
