DESCRIPTION

Layer of loose medium and small stones
in dark brown soil: looseness is its main characteristic,
distinguishes it from 16506. However, it may be that the
soil which is simply less clayey/sticky than that which composes 16506 -
not so: this layer is indeed markedly different from 16506, which lies to the
West. Q.16507 terminates northwards by filling the hollow 16527
