## DESCRIPTION

*Widespread layer of medium stones in sticky*  
*brown soil. Noticeably worn. On excavation, the removal of the upper*  
*worn stones exposed a bumpy surface of similarly severely weathered*  
*large rocks, including expanses of worn bedrock. The shape of 16506 is that of an*  
*oblong, with its axis NW-SE. It is a low platform with numerous burnt stones*  
*and areas of burnt stones. It resembles an occupation platform rather than the anticipated*  
*bank.*
