Small circular patch of burnt sub-angular l/s. with larger area of burnt l/s to periphery. 50% burnt stones & loose in light brown soil. 7.8.93: on excavation this proved to have some depth. The post-pipe seems to survive. 14cm EW, 12cm NS. On excavation, however, it seems more likely to be a stakehole. Loss for a fence line.
