ASSOCIATED FINDS 5 pieces of Romano-British ware

COMMENT The lowest of these were found at the junction of level 2 and the bedrock ^{cut} (see pre-excitation plan), would seem likely that the post hole was represented at this stage by a depression into which the Romano-British ware fell. Two levels within the post hole the upper consisting of small stones & earth, the layer ② of larger stones probably packing stones and a PHASING thick hard deposit of burnt leached soil.
