DESCRIPTION Complex of two large and one small intercut post holes. First a large post, going off under tree left standing cut by deeper second large post B. Shown by packing stones, cut into the corner of this a third but this time small and not very deep posthole. Originally showed up as an area of large flat, and pitched stones the central one of which was burnt red (see pre-excitation plan)

COMMENT A large flat stone at c. 40cm depth seemed to indicate the possible bottom of the post hole ie post stood upon it. However, the cut bottom was a c. 75cms. Both A and B produced lots of finds including charcoal in quite large amounts. In A there seemed to be a layer of packed clay against the southern edge, however it seemed to go down into a natural fissure and also to run off under the bedrock. So there it looks natural, though very strange if so. Can't understand being in A unless redeposited, perhaps clay misinterpreted during the excavation of the features. Sample of clay taken
