F2109 is basically a misnomer. At first it appeared as a
form of scoop, for F2111 being at a higher level made an
edge with it, while what appeared to be fill in F2109
down to bedrock may now just be viewed as site layer
② in a very loose, jumbled mass. None the less the bedrock
PHASING in this area is very unusual and in it two post holes
have showed up at a very low level - that is F2110
and F2112
