CUTTING 01 CO-ORDINATES: East North

DESCRIPTION Postholes and setting - double posthole and setting within F2109.

- 1 Loose black earth with much loose smallish limestone rubble.
- 2 Similar to ① but much more solid with larger limestone rubble. Heavily
- 3 Red-brown clay like soil heavily leached with small limestone fragments (leached)

COMMENT ④ light grey loam with some large pieces of limestone evident in the section.

⑤ Very loose brown soil with smallish limestone fragments

⑥ Brown soil with little limestone

⑦ Primary silt of fairly clean light brown soil

F2110a was partly destroyed on one side but still showed up as a definite separate post hole

PHASING

F2110b complete posthole - This feature showed up at a low level; indeed, it could only be seen when F2109 had been cleared down to bedrock. Sealed by F2109 fill
