DESCRIPTION A ridge running roughly NE-SW along the northern lip of a quarrying scoop. The ridge, after the removal of the turf and Layer ①, can be seen to be capped with loose, small, limestone pieces and chippies. A few larger blocks, c. 67cm in diameter can also be seen in the upper surface. Along the eastern, bottom, lip of the ridge are patches of F3801, the 'dumped' clay, overlying the loose stone cappings.
