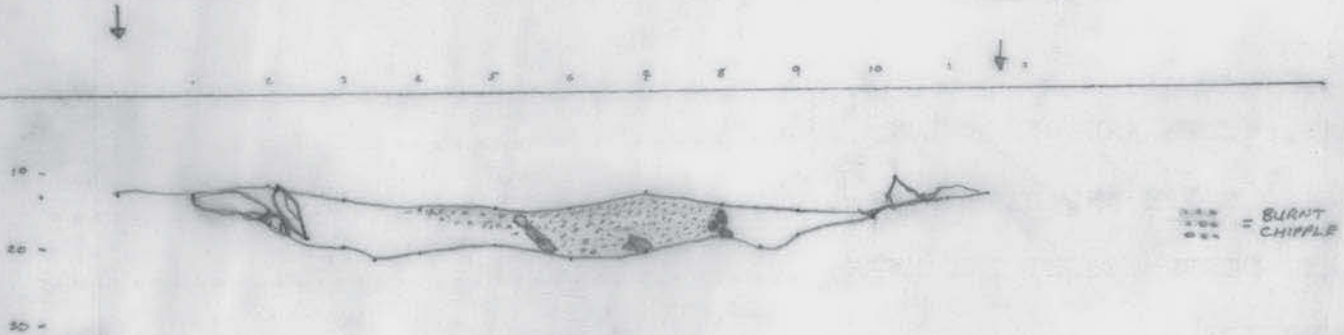

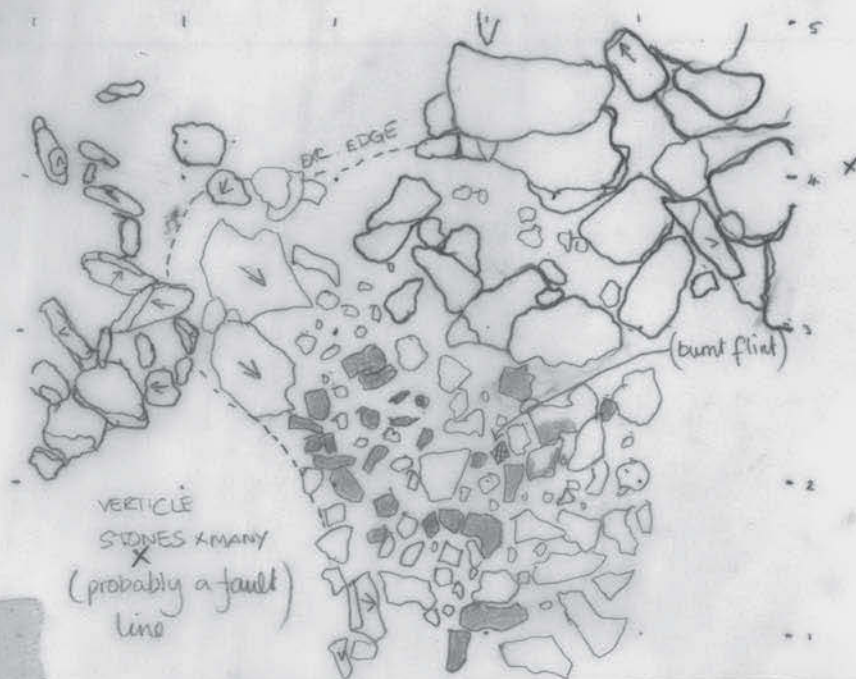


FEATURE PLAN (A) of F 8173.
