COMMENT Pto sketch plan. Different orientation of stones from 8506.  
From section evidence it appears this cuts into 8505 and 8514 and possibly into 8506 too  
18.8.88 This does seem to have been a posthole in that it goes down to bedrock cutting 8505, 8533 and contained a wealth of bone flint and some pot.
