PHASING

A pit dug beneath where 8542 cuts 8533 at its north eastern extremity went deep without showing real bedrock, just the layered rock of 8533.

Accepted as a form of bedrock, but with reservations. It is layered horizontal rock, but also is quite loose with soil matrix, and is not cemented to the "gull" material

Beneath 8505 (2) and (3) in part and 8506, but does not occur beneath 8507. ∴ cut by it.
