4/8 This feature was not a post hole. A large area of intense burning was removed (see plans and profiles overlain) but the feature was clearly expanding underneath 7914 + 7920, but in the form of jumbled limestone with occasional burnt stones rather than as intense burning.

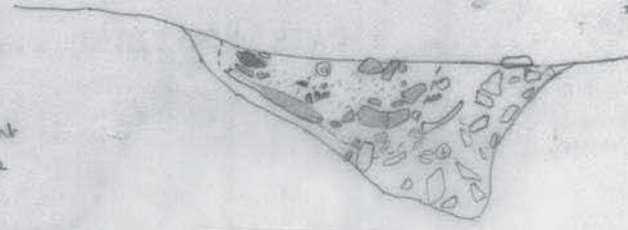
