ASSOCIATED FEATURES

ASSOCIATED FINDS <sup>Tooth - pig</sup> burnt bone x many, charcoal, carbonised nutshell x many  
flint x many. Pot x many, <sup>hath x 2</sup>  
The majority of finds are comprised of small fragments with flint and burnt  
bone predominating. The pottery was all small fragments and undiagnostic.

COMMENT This feature was found in the cutting edge of P3 after  
the removal of backfill from P4; the dimensions N-S are not known  
since the feature was not recognised in P4  
The ~~same~~ type of finds from this pit accord well with those from  
other pits in Q2.

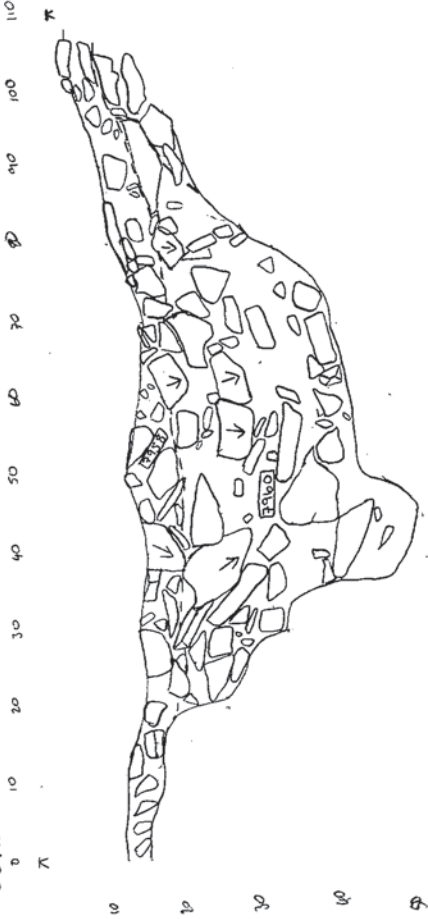
Working from the southern edge of P3 the section face of F7960
