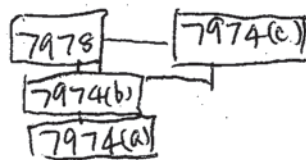

COMMENT Ndr exc. 1987 The pit 7974(a) is cut by two unequal-sized postholes. That to the N (7974(b)) is the later of the two, and the stones of 7978 have fallen into its void. That to the South (7974(b)) is sealed by the platform rubble of 7978

PHASING platform rubble 7978 overlies all but 7974(c)
