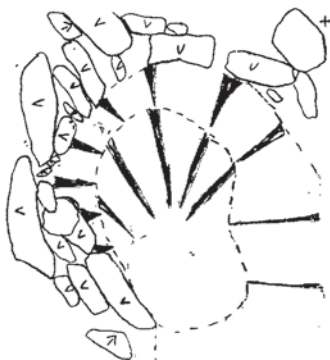

The western edge of 8010 appears to be formed by the large verticles of 8011 and here the edge is almost verticle much of the eastern edge is not visible at the top of the pit since it extends into 03 and has not been dug, however edges are visible lower down and are indicated by the dotted lines. This is also the situation for the S.E. corner of the pit
