POSTHOLE A small posthole cut into the gull, and with a shape slightly broken up by rabbit disturbance. At the surface this had showed up as an area of heavily burnt limestone but the sides did not become apparent until a low level, when all the dark material was being travelled out of the gull down to a meringue/ clean yellow surface. The finds in this feature included some very large pot sherds which were unusually thick and coarse in appearance.
