COMMENT

Appeared to be posthole on surface, but now appears to be the end of a shallow trench. At the very end of F2963 is a deep stakehole F2970 which could be interpreted as the end post of a hurdle fence perhaps.

~~PLASTIC~~ **what appeared on the surface to be a fairly clear posthole turned into an excavation and better general cleaning what is apparently a shallow bedding trench quite possibly for a fence. At the Eastern end of the 'trench'**

P.T.O.

F2963, was a small stakehole F2970 sunk further into the gull, which has the appearance of a better set end post to a hurdle fence. This is speculation to be substantiated by further excavation.

The fill of both features (if they are separate features) was the brown soil with chipple, Site layer ③
