ASSOCIATED FINDS The area produced very few finds, the packing by contrast produced ~~very few finds~~ nearly 100 pieces of pottery.

#### COMMENT

Difficult to find exact edges of post-pipe but the area produced very few finds, the packing by contrast produced nearly one hundred pieces of pottery.

Although not noticed in plan it appeared from the section that the feature contained a small post-pipe to the North whilst the rest was packing. The pipe had a fill of earth with small stones and produced very few finds, the packing however was solid with large stones tilted at many angles and produced a very large

number of pot - sherds which may be from the same pot. Bag numbers Q4 227-230, 232-233. When the second half was removed the pipe was difficult to find and some doubt may be cast on its existence. The 'packing' however still produced numerous pot sherds.

The photograph taken of this feature empty has the no 2983 instead of 2982. Its half section photograph has the correct number. Also Q4 bags 233-234 were sent in as 2983 instead of 2982 must change. Sorry about the cock up!
