COMMENT

Cut through F2981 depression, first noticed at this level but it appears from Q4 Plan 2 that it may have been cut through from the top of F2960: cuts down into 'bedrock gull'!

Pre-excavation plan of this feature is on the ~~PERMATRACE~~ plan of F2981 a supposed foundation trench which wasn't.

Showing up as a deep red patch of soil with a few

small stones, some of which were burnt, it had clearly been cut through the material which had come to fill a natural hollow F(2981). It would appear to have been cut from this level as it is overlain by the spread of F2960 → apparently some sort of support for a fence (not yet altogether final!) and did not appear to cut through F2960.

The fill was as described for the surface, plan and the feature was cut down into bedrock gull.

South half removed. Fill of red soil with chipple and occasional burnt stone. Few finds. Cut into the stonier fill of F2981. Bottom partially sits on 'gull' bedrock.
