This was not distinguishable as separate from 3642 until the morning of 1-8-80, but there were finds from above it in 3642 on 30-7-80, and it ~~must~~ ~~was~~ ~~clear~~ that we simply could not recognise it at the higher level.

SECTION: 3646 ① = 2961 is old land surface. Some ~~of~~ ~~the~~ was

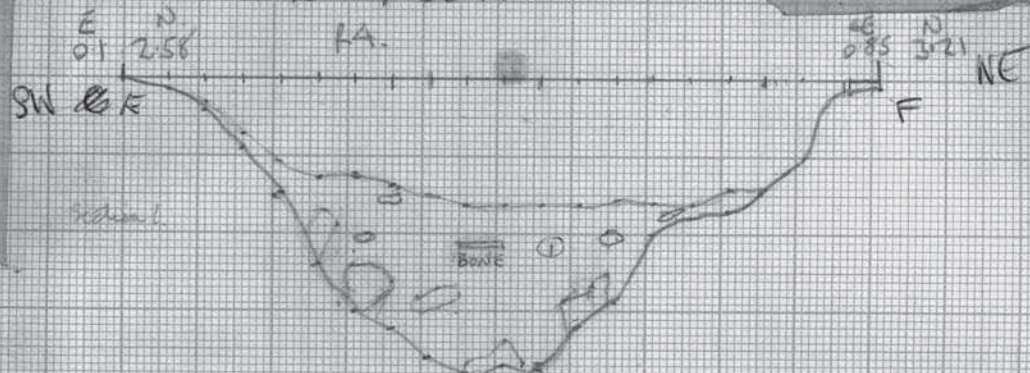
3646 (2) is very hard, concreted a gull material, apparently redeposited, ~~red~~ ~~pink~~ rather pink, and with a lot of burnt limestone fragments within it. This is very similar to other features from this area.

③ Soft pink soil layer, very similar to 2961, but poorer. Produced some charcoal. This occurred only on the NE side of the p-h - & was missed ~~on the~~ during the 2-8-80 as conditions were very dry & the excavator was concentrating on the SW side of the post-hole where ① overlies ② & ② overlies bedrock.

④ Soft yellow watercolor gull.  
From 8-8-80 ② + ③ will be reversed + ~~②~~ ④ + ④ actually be overcut bed rock.

From 8-8-80 ② + ③ will be reversed + ③ + ④ will be overcut bedrock

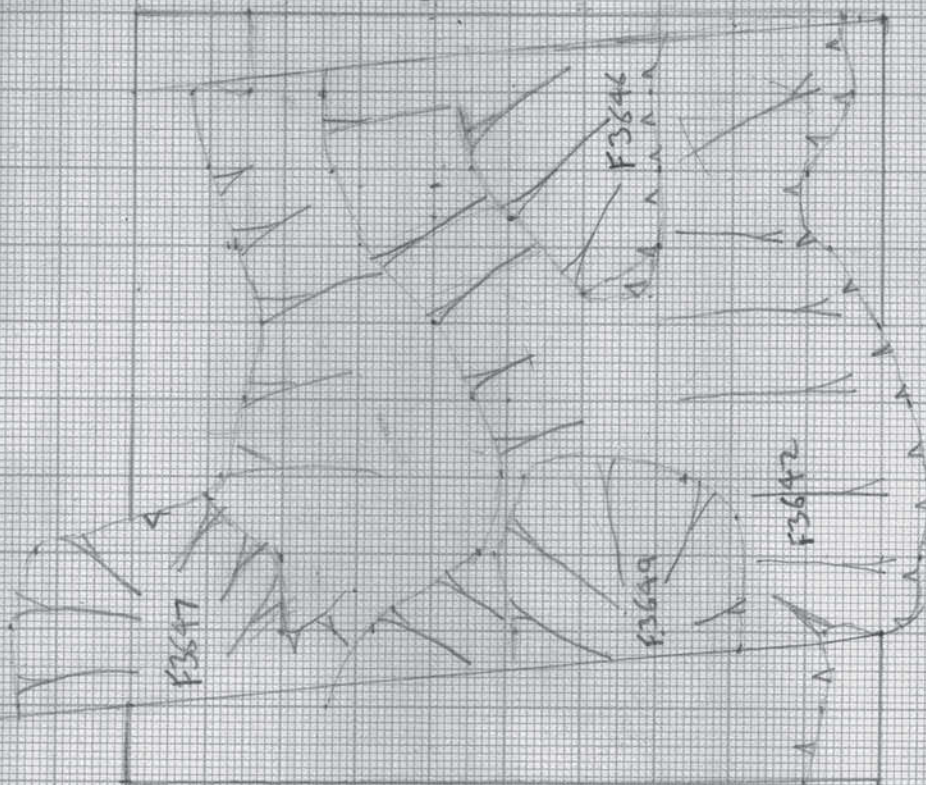
