COMMENT *Stones can be seen on Plan 8 (10 cm), 9 (15 cm)*
At below 5-10 amount of charred, burnt bones, burnt limestone discovered
At 15-20 cm - deeply large pieces of bone appeared
5 cm below depth at which stones were numbered dk grey area appeared
F3774, 3775, ~~3776, 3777~~
Stones disappear but number continued to be used to distinguish area

PHASING *in line of stone q to the w
from arm*

The S edge of the feature appears to be a cut.
Fill mix of Red brown/orange brown/yellow-orange/dk grey is dumped material
