ASSOCIATED FINDS Tiny bag of pottery.

#### COMMENT

Some small burnt stones (pink) in interstices of rock lumps: root action? Finds ascribed to this number because of this factor i.e. at time of writing (25-7-87) not entirely certain that all of the rock lumps are in situ.

PHASING NB: this is bedrock. The wider interstices are frost-cracked fissures on edge of gull to S.
