ASSOCIATED FEATURES *8327*

ASSOCIATED FINDS *None. Burnt seed grain.*

COMMENT *Wide, flattish bottom but with small hollows between concreted stones: the hollows cannot be positively identified as stake holes and are thus not numbered. This hollow was infilled with 8327 and then a wash or dump of red chipples (8314) deposited.*

PHASING *NB: the hollow below 8326 (8345) may be the same, but reddened by leaching from 8314*
