COMMENT

This natural downslope wash post-dates ^{certain} archaeological features ~~of~~ of this cutting (8350, 8352, 8365); one feature (8360) cuts 8361 and is overlain by 8331, but the two layers 8331/8361 seem to ^{be} lithologically & chronologically the same i.e. no significant time-period separates them.
