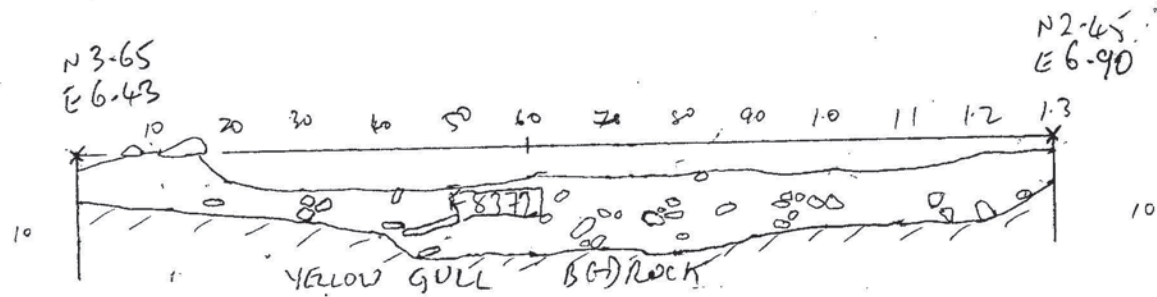

PHASING Pre 8331 ∴ prob. Neolithic.

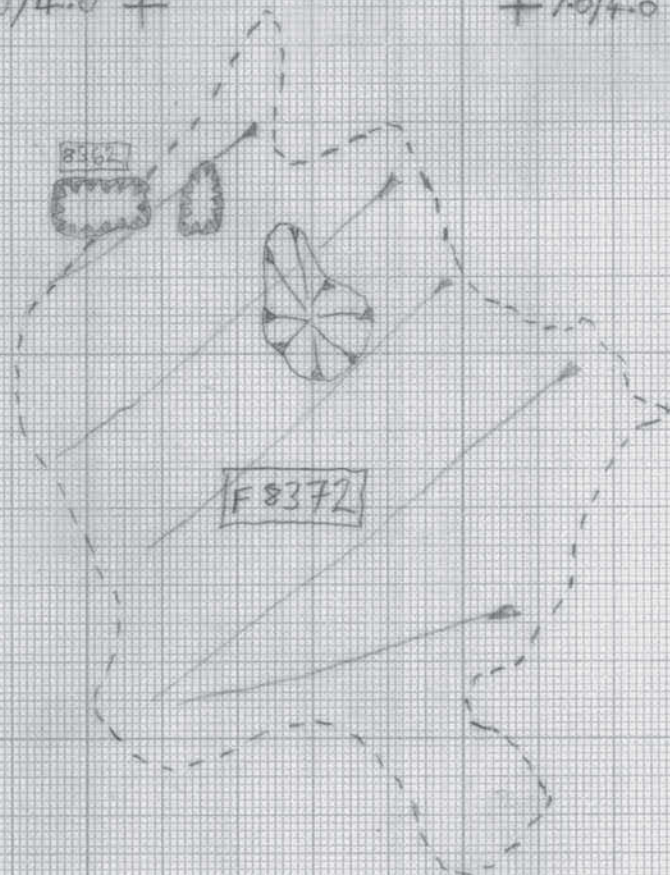
