COMMENT No difference in material from 5935 but plattishness is visible from lower down slope. This "hollow-way" is path-sized but is not reflected by profile of modern track or in any visible paths. It separates 5935 from 5897

PHASING It contains burnt small stones. It is later than the adjacent "hump" of rocks 5911

SECTION:

11-8-84 : 5940 is a fence-line - probably a fence-trench with stakes at intervals.

Concentrations of burning along the line: a red soil matrix.
