COMMENT Some of this seems to be tumbled small rubble, but severely weathered bedrock protrudes from it, & this latter may well represent old land surface. A 1m-wide trench was excavated through this weathered belt: it showed an extra shelf of rock beneath the small rubble & soil. (See FP).
