There is a "step" on the W. side of 9600 (stone cairn) infilling the angle formed between the higher parts of 9600. 9626 lies 9627. 9627 is of similar material to 9600 & may be stone cairn extension over the "step" (CHECK if matches change in Be dark) P.T.O.

though there are a few angled / vertical stones that may indicate
that 9627 is "collique".
