IC was easy to distinguish 9600 & 10416 in excavation.

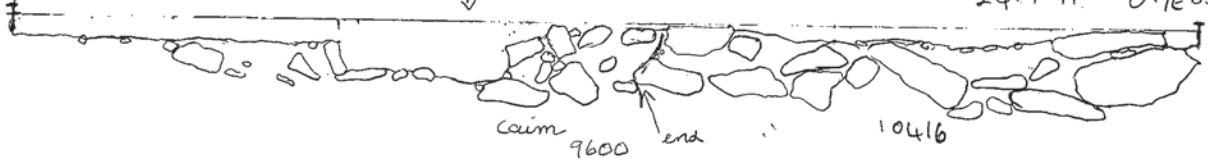
