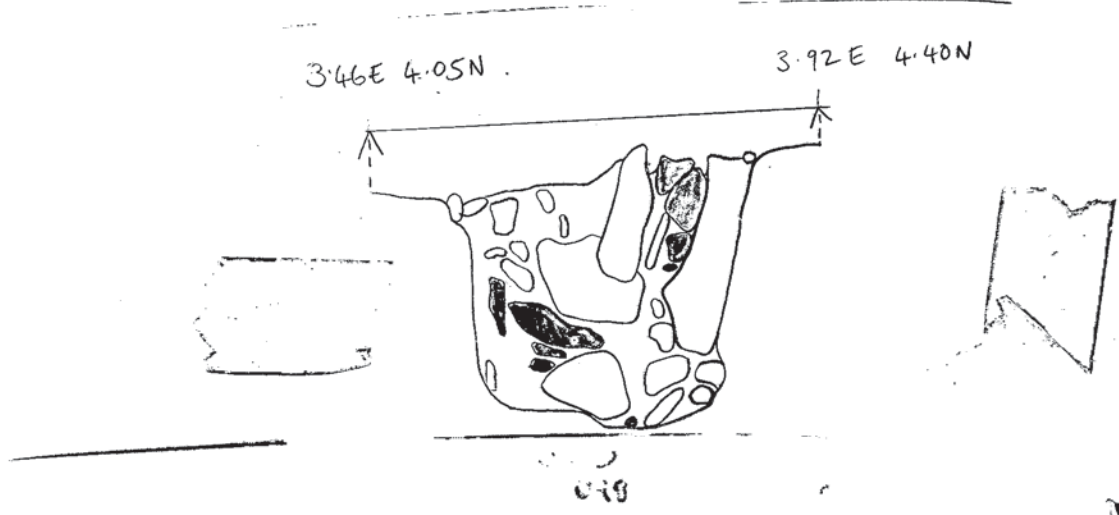

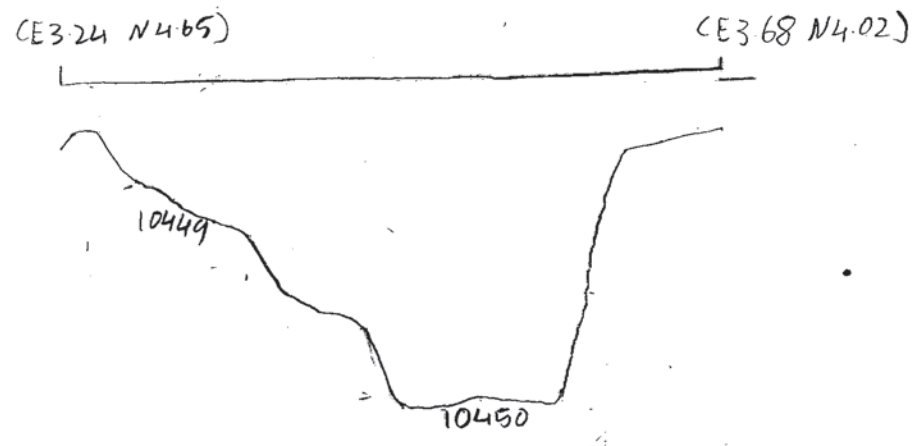
Comments

The burnt stone (shown a section) + anor channel continued to base of P.H.
with a few small burnt stone nodules between top + base of the drawn section.
Packing stones (NE 10249) occurred principally on N P20

edge.
 The edge of 10450/10449, having removed all the pipe & packing is not particularly clear
 left as no burning / angled stone present.
 Depth diff between section & profile is due to the small-medium burnt stones
 being left in in the section & being removed for the profile.
