20-8-85: → Prob. packing stones for a post built structure.

PHASING This "wall" tapers out at W 92 N 0.0/E 2.0.
Its line may be traced SW-wards in the form of 6846, a

patch of bund stones. No further trace was
found. SW-wards of these wall packing stones,
the underlying gully 6881 could not be
discerned either (this will be resolved on final
re-opening in 1987/88).

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
