COMMENT

This spine consists of a belt of vertical & pitched slabs
10-8-85: on excavation of the W. continuation of 5939, the latter appeared to run under 6850 ~~6850 is not a spine of joint breccia~~

14-8-85: on sectioning, 6850 seems to consist of upended cracked bedrock; the "spine" itself was deliberately left when the shallow "ditch" was excavated. The upending and cracking was exacerbated by the subsequent digging of 5939 ditch.
