COMMENT

On excavation, this feature looked convincingly like a structural element in the bank; however, the very large block of stone bounding its E. side fitted the nearby bedrock shelf 6802 exactly, with a 20cm gap between. It could have cracked off and slid. However, such erosive effects would not necessarily invalidate the 6801 feature as having been man-made.
