COMMENT

On X93 Plan 1, a vague line of small burnt stones extends W-wards of 6846. En route and during excavation, a line of medium sized lumps (6855) some burnt, lay in this area. If these are all of any significance, the "round-house" 6840 might in fact have had an oblong shape.
