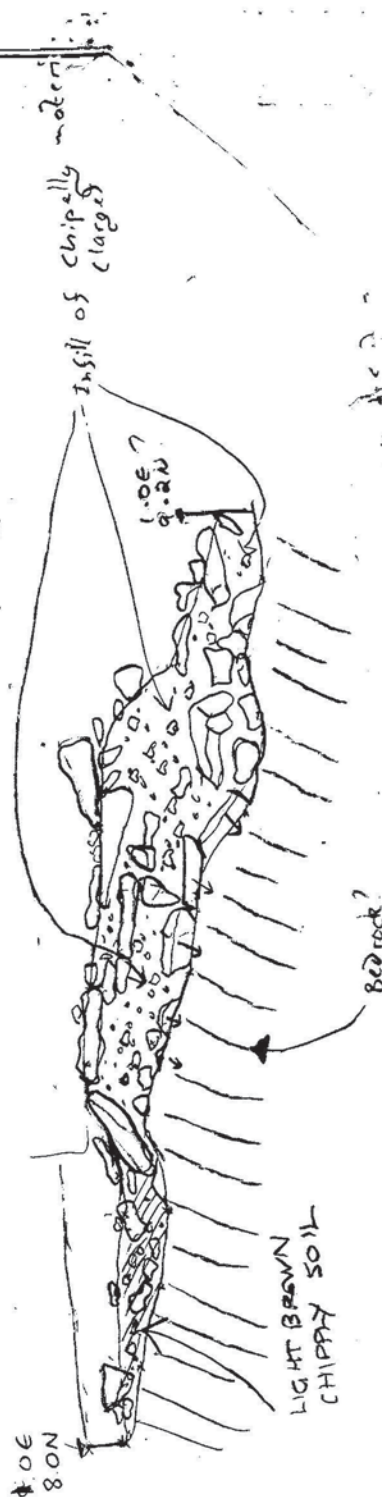
PHASING
