DESCRIPTION

Widespread layer of light brown soil 50%
and small stones 50%, seeming to bind
areas of large slabs e.g. 15407, 15412: probably a downslope
wash sealing another widespread layer (15415) further up slope. The limits of this
layer are very difficult to determine: it may extend Nwards into X90 i.e.
15411 is a catch-all number where lateral and vertical limits are hard to see.
