2 sherds pot. Although this layer of mainly rubble overlies 6832 it does not appear ~~of~~ on the NE/SW section across 6832/6836. This rubble runs in a sinuous line from X93 E. 9m N5m. Certainly in its upper stretch, it gives appearance of having been collapse of a 1d entrance wall (on west side of such an entrance passage).
