COMMENT Below 6926 - it may be that 6926 represents merely the traces of burnt posts set in 6936 and extending through the nibbly material above.

6936 and 6940 appear to represent a patisade trench running NW/SE across the area (see sketch plan at 12/8/85 in notebook).

On further excavation it became clear that these features were at least partly natural, ~~as they~~ as they were based in the ~~clearance~~ clearance ~~plains~~
