DESCRIPTION Cut feature in limestone gull, packed with medium-sized angular limestone frags. Fill of light brown sandy clay loam with burnt limestone and flecks of charcoal. large angular frags. of limestone also in fill. At Southern end a post void was detected (see profile, sect. 22)

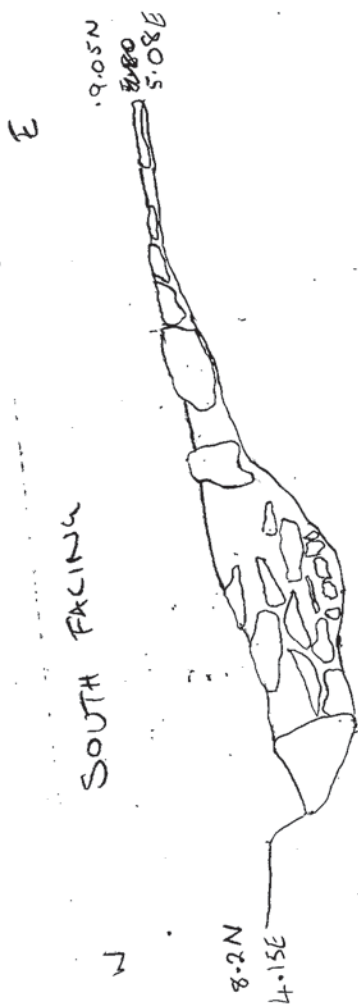
ASSOCIATED FEATURES 6936
