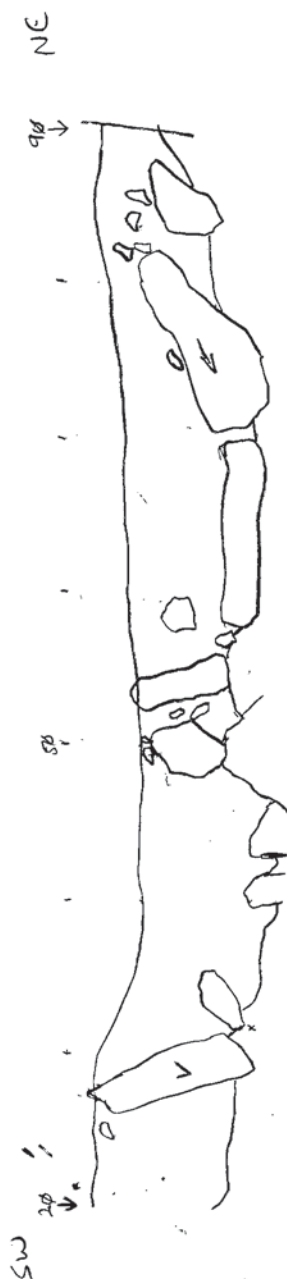

much chert fill.

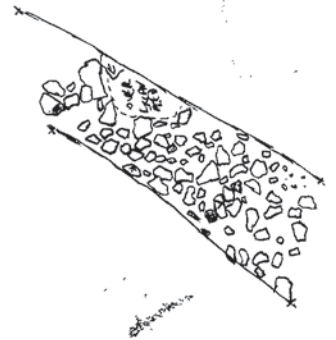
