Cooking pit? Has been successively re-lined.

Its surface plan is different from its original shape: as  
a cooking pit it was 5-sided; re-lined until perhaps too  
small to use; filled in with soil, and laid over  
with a flat slab. This latter may just be fortuitous,  
although having the appearance of a post-slab.
