6001 and 6002 are the uppermost layers of friable bedrock
appearing as chippie on top and conchering into a yellowish
and soft, top layer of bedrock. This seems to be a feature
associated on the route of the ~~water flow~~ ^(gully) down the hill.
This layer was mainly excavated in arbitrary levels because of the depth
of the deposit in sensitive areas.
